

Terms and Conditions

TP-NECDC Virtual Challenge is co-organised by Temasek Polytechnic Student Development & Alumni Affairs and North East Community Development Council (“the ORGANISER”). It is an event that encourages walking, running, and cycling, and it is open for participation to Temasek Polytechnic students and staff, alumni as well as members of the public.

Participants of this Virtual Challenge agree to the following:

DEFINITIONS

“Finisher” refers to the participant who has completed the distance within the stipulated date and time and has received a confirmation email from the Organiser, confirming his/her accomplishment.

1. Registration

a. All participants of the Virtual Challenge must submit their registration online via the link provided by the organiser.

b. Participants must register for the Virtual Run by 2359 hours, 14 November 2021, Singapore Time, unless another date is stipulated by the Organiser. Otherwise, the registration will be deemed as invalid and the Organiser reserves the right to reject them without notice.

c. The participant can sign up for either of the following categories:

- Leisure Walk 3km
- Leisure Run 5.6km
- Fitness Challenge 25km
- Cycle 56km

d. All participants have to be 21 years old and above at the time of registration. All participants below the age of 21 years are required to seek parental/guardian consent to participate in the event. Relevant indemnity and declaration fields must be fully completed at the point of registration - failing which, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse registration to the participant or to nullify the participant’s race entry without notice.

e. The participant must provide true, accurate, current and complete information about himself/herself in the online registration form. If a participant provides any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, or if the Organiser has any grounds to suspect that such information is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, the participant's registration may be rejected, suspended or terminated without reason and without notice.

- f. Registration is only confirmed upon issuance of a confirmation email from the Organiser.
- g. All entries to the TP-NECDC Virtual Challenge are based on a first-come first-served basis.
- h. The Organiser shall not be responsible for any Ineligibility arising from inaccurate or incomplete entry details.

2. Rules and Regulations

- a. All Rules and Regulations are subject to resolution by the Organiser whose decision shall be final.
- b. Only Strava App can be used to qualify for completion of the selected run distance. Strava App is available for download on all Android and iOS platforms.
- c. Participants for the Leisure Walk (3KM) and Recreation Run (5.6KM) categories are required to complete their run between 15 November 2021, 0000 hours to 30 November 2021, 2359 hours. Participants for the Fitness Challenge Run 25KM and 56 Km Cycling categories will also have to complete their run between 15 November 2021, 0000 hours to 31 December 2021. Any distance covered out of the stipulated race period and incomplete running details will not be considered.
- d. It is the participant's responsibility to track the distances covered within the stipulated race period and to submit the walking, running, cycling details to the Organiser via the official link as evidence of completing the race. Participants must follow the submission format as specified in the tutorial videos.
- e. Only participants who have received a confirmation email from the Organiser, notifying him/her of the successful completion, will be deemed as having successfully completed the race. The Organiser will not entertain any failure to provide the evidence of proof or any failure to adhere to the submission format.
- f. Upon successful completion of the Virtual Charity Challenge, participants will be notified by email the details for physical collection of their finisher entitlements. Any finisher entitlement that remains uncollected after 3 months from the collection date may be dispensed with by the Organiser at its sole and absolute discretion.

3. Health and Risks Involved

- a. Every participant is responsible for his/her involvement in the Virtual Challenge. Temasek Polytechnic, the Organiser, the event sponsors and representatives will not be liable for any injuries, mishaps, sickness, death and/or loss/damage to personal property that may occur during or otherwise arising from the Virtual Challenge. Every participant needs to be aware that his/her participation in the Virtual Challenge may be physically

demanding and may involve a certain amount of risk and in choosing to participate, every participant acknowledges that he/she accepts all risks associated with participation in the Virtual Challenge and that such acceptance is a precondition to his/her participation. Every participant shall therefore not hold Temasek Polytechnic, the Organiser, the event sponsors and their representatives, liable for any damage to or loss of property or any injury or loss of life which may be sustained by the participant during the course or arising from any cause in connection with his/her participation in the Virtual Charity Challenge.

b. Participants are strongly encouraged to seek clearance from their own medical practitioners prior to registration and before participation in the Virtual Charity Challenge.

c. During the event, participants are required to adhere to the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Control Order) Regulations 2021 or any other prevailing government advisories on COVID-19.

d. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, postpone or rectify the dates of the event as needed, giving at least 1 day of notice before the event.

e. The Organiser may contact the Participant from time to time by email regarding race matters. Any notice sent to the email address registered with the Organiser shall be deemed as received and read by the Participant.

4. Personal Data

a. Collection of participants' personal data is necessary for the purpose of the Virtual Challenge.

b. By submitting an entry form, each participant consents to the collection, use or disclosure/access of his/her personal data by the Organiser, Temasek Polytechnic, the event sponsors and representatives.

c. The Virtual Challenge requires participants to download and use Strava Running Mobile App to record their running activities. By downloading the app, participants grant access to their personal data being stored, used or disclosed by the Strava Running Mobile App. The Organiser, Temasek Polytechnic, the event sponsors and representatives will therefore not be liable for any misuse or violations of personal data by the Strava Running Mobile App that may occur.

d. Participants permit the use of their photos or videos taken during the Virtual Charity Challenge by the Organiser, Temasek Polytechnic, the event sponsors and representatives for promotional purposes, with no rights to claim for any compensation arising for that reason.
